While we may not fully comprehend all of God's reasons, we open ourselves to the real possibility of miracles whenever we "preach the Gospel to all creation" through our praying, giving, and going.



"I have witnessed the power of God's healing through this ministry. I will never forget the day when a woman was healed from cancer, and her doctor confirmed it. It was a miracle that filled me with hope and strengthened my faith. There was also another individual who was healed from a nerve disease in Jesus' name. Seeing these miraculous healings and at least 70 people accepting Jesus through them has been an incredible experience."

"Through it all, God remains by our side. He gives us the strength and determination we need to keep moving forward. As we continue to work, we see miracles happening all around us. I am overwhelmed with gratitude for everything that God has done in my life. He saved me, protected me, and called me to a life of service to him.

And through it all, he has been with me every step of the way."

"God has brought forth many miracles. I started this ministry in an empty house where I prayed for people's deliverance. A lady who couldn't get pregnant for 15 years did after I prayed for her. I had a girl whose hands were affected by a particular disease. After I prayed for her, she fell to the ground, and when she stood up, she started to use her hands. We now have more than 29 members, and the church has elders, deacons, and evangelists. Even though I started in an empty house, God has given me these people. I use every opportunity to teach people about Jesus. I thank God for being with me."

"When I opened the church in the village, it was a turning point for many people. The gospel has transformed so many lives, and I have been privileged to witness the power of God in action. Miracles have happened right before my eyes. When I pray for the sick, they are healed. It's a reminder of God's love and grace for his people."

"I have seen firsthand how God can work miracles through me. One woman in my villages was healed from HIV and AIDS. Her healing was a testament to the power of God and it gave me the courage to continue on this journey. Another woman was healed from an injury on her hand, and through her healing, her husband accepted Jesus.

Speaking of miracles, I have personally experienced God's healing power in my life. Before coming to Christ I struggled with madness before God healed me and called me to be a missionary to the unreached. Since then, I have been working tirelessly to reach the unreached around me. There are so many people here who have yet to hear the Good News and remain lost in darkness. I want to plant a church so that it can light the darkness."

"I am grateful for the miracles God has done in the lives of the people in our community. One time, a young girl who was mad in her head was healed when I prayed for her. This miracle caused the church to grow very quickly.

Also, a woman who was struggling with alcoholism came to me for prayer. She was delivered, and many people saw what God had done in her life, and they came to believe."

"The people in our village have been receptive to the Gospel, and many have come to know Christ. It is amazing to see how they have turned away from idol worship and how miracles and healings are taking place.

However, there are still many challenges we face. Other churches in the area are claiming that our church is false and that we are preaching a false Gospel. We also face persecution on the roads between our village and safety is a constant concern.

Despite these challenges, we are determined to continue sharing the Good News and bringing people to Christ. We need your prayers for safety and for the hearts of those who hear our message to be changed. We also need prayers for those who believe in cultural and false religions to come to know the truth and serve the one true God."
