
#### **HOW IT WORKS**

Accomplishing this task requires a collaborative effort of like-minded partnerships united in a single purpose to fulfill the Great Commission. Our partnerships transcend denominational and organizational boundaries, uniting us in the essentials of the Christian faith and showcasing the fruit of the Spirit in all our actions.

All partners operate in a manner consistent with the World Evangelical Alliance (WEA) Statement of Faith. Throughout our journey together, we adhere to seven missional values through which we **share**, **show**, **and spread** the Good News of Jesus.

#### **RESULT = REDEMPTIVE LIFT**

A previously unreached community has a new biblically faithful, numerically growing, denominationally connected, socially transformative local church that is self-governing, self-sustaining, and self-propagating.



#### 1 Donors and Sponsors

Individuals, churches, organizations, and foundations faithfully giving to support and create Redemptive Lift, ending spiritual and physical poverty among the unreached.

#### 2 Petros Network

A global organization empowering indigenous leaders to end spiritual and physical poverty through Redemptive Lift.

#### **3 Sending Church**

An association or denomination that recruits, supports, and oversees church planters in-country in partnership with Petros Network.

#### **4 Church Planter**

An indigenous person chosen by their Sending Church to plant churches and make disciples in unreached communities.

#### **OUR MISSIONAL VALUES**

- The Local Church as the Hope of the World: We believe the local Church is God's vehicle to demonstrate His Kingdom.
- Reaching the Unreached: Our focus is on those who have never heard about Jesus, typically 98% unreached.
- 3) Equipping Indigenous Leaders: We contextualize the Gospel to the cultures where it is proclaimed.
- 4) Cooperative Partnerships: We bring multiple denominations, sending churches and agencies together for the common purpose of Kingdom building.
- Sustainability: Every missionary and project is launched with sustainability in mind.
- 6) Rapid Reproduction: Living things are designed to grow, and we promote rapid, healthy growth.
- 7) Redemptive Lift: We aim to improve all aspects of village life to bring honor to Jesus and credibility to the Gospel and the Church.

### **Petros Network (PN)**

- Shares the PN Story to global donors
- · Partners collaboratively with SC
- Prepares the Global Spiritual Mapping Strategy for each country
- Demonstrates impact through data reporting and storytelling
- Connects regional cohorts of CPs through PN leadership structure
- Coaches CPs in a holistic strategy to plant Community Hubs of Hope
- Provides contextualized in-country and digital training for Church Planter Leadership Certification
- Supplies Bibles and training materials
- Educates on sustainability initiatives
- Invests in CPs for monthly support, CP kits, and area leadership development
- Provides Seed Sustainability Grants
- Advocates for compassion projects
- Provides CPs with a Church Planting Leadership Certificate at the end of three years



## **Sending Church (SC)**IN-COUNTRY

- Partners with PN and supports its methodology
- Agrees with the World Evangelical Alliance (WEA) Statement of Faith
- Recruits and vets CP to represent the SC
- Transfers monthly sponsorship from PN to the CP as agreed
- Ensures CP monthly impact reports are complete and on time

## DUCATE

- Ensures CP understands SC distinctives and governance
- Assists with logistics and coursework for intensive training events
- Helps acquire Bibles and evangelism materials in appropriate languages

## POWER

- Provides spiritual oversight for the CP
- Helps communicate field stories and impact
- Receives a Certified CP at the end of the three-year program



## Church Planter (CP)

IGAGE

- Confirms their calling and completes the PN application
- Agrees with the World Evangelical Alliance (WEA) Statement of Faith
- Works with the SC to embed within an unreached community
- Provides monthly field activity reports and long-term data (1 and 5 years post-program)
- Remains connected and accountable to SC before, during, and after connection with PN
- Lives as a faithful ambassador of Jesus Christ, living by biblical values

UCATE

- Attends multiple intensive training events and digital learning opportunities
- Demonstrates competency to receive the PN Church Planting Leadership Certificate
- Receives sustainability training to advance personal and family income
- Identifies and communicates local compassion needs to leadership
- Commits to and completes PN three-year program

EMPOWE

- Plants a church as a *Community Hub of*Hope, impacting their village for generations
- Makes disciples who make more disciples
- Plants a church that plants churches
- Teaches others what they learn, advancing community development
- Launches and leads a sustainability project, teaching their community to do the same
